Overview

Phillip Hilder will facilitate this training for staff that work with clients who may have experienced trauma in their lives. Philip is a registered psychologist with 25 years counselling and mental health experience. His clinical training and interest is in the assessment and treatment of addictions and mental health issues that stem from complex trauma.

The training will delineate, as the ground breaking research into trauma-informed practice demonstrates, that many presenting emotional and behavioral difficulties are adaptive or 'normal' responses to abnormal situations. This training will provide participants with the insight and tools to enhance client outcomes and minimize the risk of re-traumatisation.

At the end of the training you will:

- Demonstrate knowledge of the types, impacts and prevalence of trauma on the mind and body, including links to emotional and physical health problems.
- Demonstrate knowledge of the 5 principles of trauma-informed practice and the essential role of a trauma-informed approach in service provision and individual practice.
- Be confident to conduct an organisational/personal trauma-informed practice audit.
- Understand the historical underpinnings of mental health concepts, non-trauma informed practice and re-traumatisation prevention.
