

# Special Resolution

## FURTHER INFORMATION



At the annual general meeting of the Illawarra Forum Incorporated to be held on 7 December 2017, members will consider a special resolution to change the name of the Association, and to adopt a new constitution.

Illawarra Forum Incorporated was established in 1990 to be a central body that could speak out and challenge a range of issues on behalf of the community services sector in the Illawarra and Shoalhaven. Illawarra Forum began with a group of people coming together, and the word Forum embodied the work at that time.

That group of committed individuals could not have foreseen how the Illawarra Forum would grow, and for the past 16 years we have been delivering a range of

services across a much larger geographical reach including having an office at Batemans Bay. So the name Illawarra Forum no longer adequately reflects the organisation.

The association therefore proposes to change its name to Community Industry Group -reflecting the collective and action based nature of its work in a professional industry.

The new constitution to be considered includes the following changes:

- The change of organisation name to Community Industry Group.
- Changes to geographical references which broaden the scope of work and membership of the organisation.
